

Environmentally friendly waste disposal device **showcased at Arab Health**

A simple, inexpensive and effective way of disposing of surgical waste, the polymer gelling technology rapidly absorbs gels and liquids promoting a cleaner and safer working environment.

Also at the show will be spill contingency management equipment - the Chemical Spill Station - which can deal with hazardous chemical spills quickly and efficiently. The kit ensures hospitals are always prepared for emergencies and in the event of a spillage, departments can continue to function smoothly and staff and patients are kept safe.
