

‘Green’ warehouses for Emirates Industrial City

Al Hanoo Holding has announced a series of environmental initiatives for its Emirates Industrial City project in Sharjah.

The complex, which includes warehousing facilities and logistics support services that cover an area of 20 million square feet, is being constructed with the latest standards in sustainability, according to general manager Mohammed Al Hazaa.

“Sustainability is a top priority for Emirates Industrial City. From the very start, we have ensured the project is compatible with global standards in terms of protecting the environment,” he said.

“A range of measures have been implemented, such as distributing project areas in an even manner, in which roads fit with the total project area, and treating and preparing soil to be ready for construction work, without damaging the environment. Investors were told to maintain these points during the development process.”

Al Hanoo Holding, one of the largest real estate companies in the Middle East, has also started a marketing campaign for the warehousing complex in Emirates Industrial City, with a number of companies expressing their interest in the project.

“The project is divided into eight sections, two of which have been specified for warehouses and logistic support. This will include 400 warehouses, which can be further sub-divided into as many as 4000 warehouses,” added Al Hazaa.
