Dr. Khan has served as Co-Guide for various MS Orthopedic Surgery, DM Medical Oncology and MD Pathology thesis and has lectured at various National and International conferences.

Dr. Khan also serves as Editorial Board Member of the Indian Journal of Orthopedics, and is an International Board Member of the Journal of Clinical Rehabilitative Tissue Engineering Research (China), Reviewer of Scottish Medical Journal (UK), Reviewer Journal of Children's Orthopedics (France) and Reviewer of Annals of Saudi Medicine.

He has recently been selected as Senior Editor with the Medjaden Biomedical Services, Hong Kong.

His other distinctions include life memberships of the World Orthopedic Concern, UK, Indian Orthopedic Association, Bombay Orthopedic Society, Life Member Indian Academy of Cerebral Palsy, Founder Life Member of Central Zone of Orthopedics, India and Member AO Alumni, AO Swiss. Besides he has also served as an expert on several National Committees of the Government of India. Dr. Khan has extensive presentations. His papers have been selected on two occasions for podium presentations at the Annual Meeting of the prestigious American Academy of Orthopedic Surgeons.
